Our vision für Salzburg

GREEN MOBILITY TRANSFORMATION & CREATING SPACE FOR PEOPLE

- ➔ Urban development for sustainable, climate-friendly and people-centric mobility
- ➔ Full commitment to better public transport: 7.5 to 10-minute intervals, affordable tickets, comfortable buses.
- ➔ Campaign for a seamless cycle path network on which all cyclists feel safe.
- ➔ Traffic reduction in the city center from Neutor to Hanuschplatz.
- ➔ Creating green oases instead of asphalt deserts - in all parts of the city.
- ➔ For example, we want to green Mirabellplatz and turn the Rot-Kreuz parking lot into a park.
- ➔ Create a car-sharing scheme for the entire city. Traffic reduction in the districts & more space and safety for pedestrians.
- ➔ Plant 1,000 new trees & expand green energy production.



MORE AFFORDABLE HOUSING

- ➔ Ending the housing policy standstill & full commitment to affordable housing
- ➔ Hundreds of new apartments - through the construction of housing in already sealed, but underutilised areas in commercial zones, sensitive redensification of existing buildings and the consistent overbuilding of supermarkets. No to encroaching on the green belt around the city!
- ➔ Mobilise vacant buildings & end speculation with housing. Priority for subsidised rental housing. In order to enable ownership, we focus on the construction of rent-to-own apartments.
- ➔ Promote communal living and intergenerational housing projects.



LOOK AFTER EACH OTHER, INSTEAD OF WORKING AGAINST EACH OTHER

With these and more measures, we are committed to a more liveable Salzburg, where everyone has the chance to lead a fulfilling life.

- ➔ More public, affordable childcare facilities & longer opening hours.
- ➔ More open spaces and affordable housing for young people.
- ➔ Good framework conditions in nursing homes for the elderly & a strategy to combat loneliness.
- ➔ For a change of course at the Salzburg AG: The focus should not be on dividends, but on the affordable basic supply of water, energy and electricity for Salzburg residents.
